<u>1. Overview</u>

Frontiers of Physics is an annual conference for teachers of physics run by the Institute of Physics. It takes place on a Saturday in September and usually, close to 100 teachers attend Frontiers from all parts of Ireland. Frontiers of Physics offers a blend of lectures, workshops, exhibitors, and networking opportunities. Paul Nugent designed and delivered Frontiers most years since the first event in 2001. At this Hub he recollected some of the highlights from and shared links to an archive of over 70 videos of lectures and workshops from past Frontiers conferences.
